Amendments to the Use Class Order

The Government have published amendments to the use class order, which come into force on 1st September 2020. The Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 make significant changes to the use classes, with potentially wide ranging implications.

The amendments specify that for any building or land within the newly defined use classes, any change of use within the same class is not considered development. This will provide significantly more options for the use of buildings and land, with retail units, offices, and so on, able to change between the 'commercial, business and service' uses.
